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▼ With its flared silhouette and Natural White finish, the Worcester tub would enhance any bathroom space, be it traditional or contemporary. Ribbing on its rim and plinth, which conceals the pipework, pays homage to detailing typical of vintage stonework, while the symmetrical design generates an angle ideal for reclining. \$6,980. ► Eponymously named to evoke the spirit of the New England summer destination, the new Cape Cod bathroom series by Duravit, designed by Philippe Starck, blurs indoor-outdoor parameters by implementing organic shapes and natural materials. The solid-wood console vanity features a high-gloss white surface and splayed chrome legs that give it a lightweight, novel profile with a fresh, modern appeal. Vanity, 44" x 22", \$8,508. ▼ Statuario Nuvo—a brand-new interpretation of marble from Caesarstone, which pioneered the use of quartz for surfaces—showcases elegant dark veining on a white background with a subtly diffused veined subsurface. Among nature's most durable materials, quartz is resistant to stains, scratches and cracks, as well as to heat and cold. \$42 per square foot, excluding installation.



◀ This wall-hung ceramic wash basin with integrated counter from Le Giare Collection exemplifies the Italian company Ceramica Cielo's penchant for sculptural bathroom fixtures and accoutrements without sacrificing functionality. Its organic half-egg shape, enhanced by the full oval of the mirror above it, is distinctly off-centre—a testament to the designer's confident sensibility.
