Mixing Victorian, traditional, and classic elements brings a hint of the country to a kitchen. Here's how this kitchen combined products for a nostalgic look.

1 WALL COLOR

Adding a coat of paint is one of the easiest and least expensive ways to add color to any room. This light yellow hue is bright and cheery without being overwhelming.

2 TEXTURED TILE

A tiled backsplash protects the wall around the sink from splashes. To stretch the budget, the tile is just two rows high rather than reaching the ceiling.

3 PAINTED CABINETS

Consider painted versions of cabinets; they add a splash of color and personality.

4 METALLIC BACKSPLASH

Copper sheets nailed to the wall deflect heat from the range and make cleaning up spills easy.
