






BAMBOO VANITY THE FURNITURE GUILD

The vanity features a bamboo veneer and is available in more than 40 distinctive finishes and other wood species. Making smart use of space, the vanity has two doors for storage with adjustable shelves and a center section that drops forward to give access to plumbing. It can be custom sized and either comes with brushed stainless legs or can be wall-mounted.
