The ceramic Carrara 12"x35" wall tile and the porcelain Carrara 24"x24" floor tile from the Classic Carrara Blanco Marble line, actually appear as Carrara Marble, but the smooth polished finish makes cleaning simple and the grout is barely visible thanks to the large tile format and rectified edges. Prism Bianco is another new tile for 2012. This three-dimensional, smooth textured décor is both unique and stunning. Each square exudes its own small pyramid shape, and when shown as a whole can become a striking pattern.
