

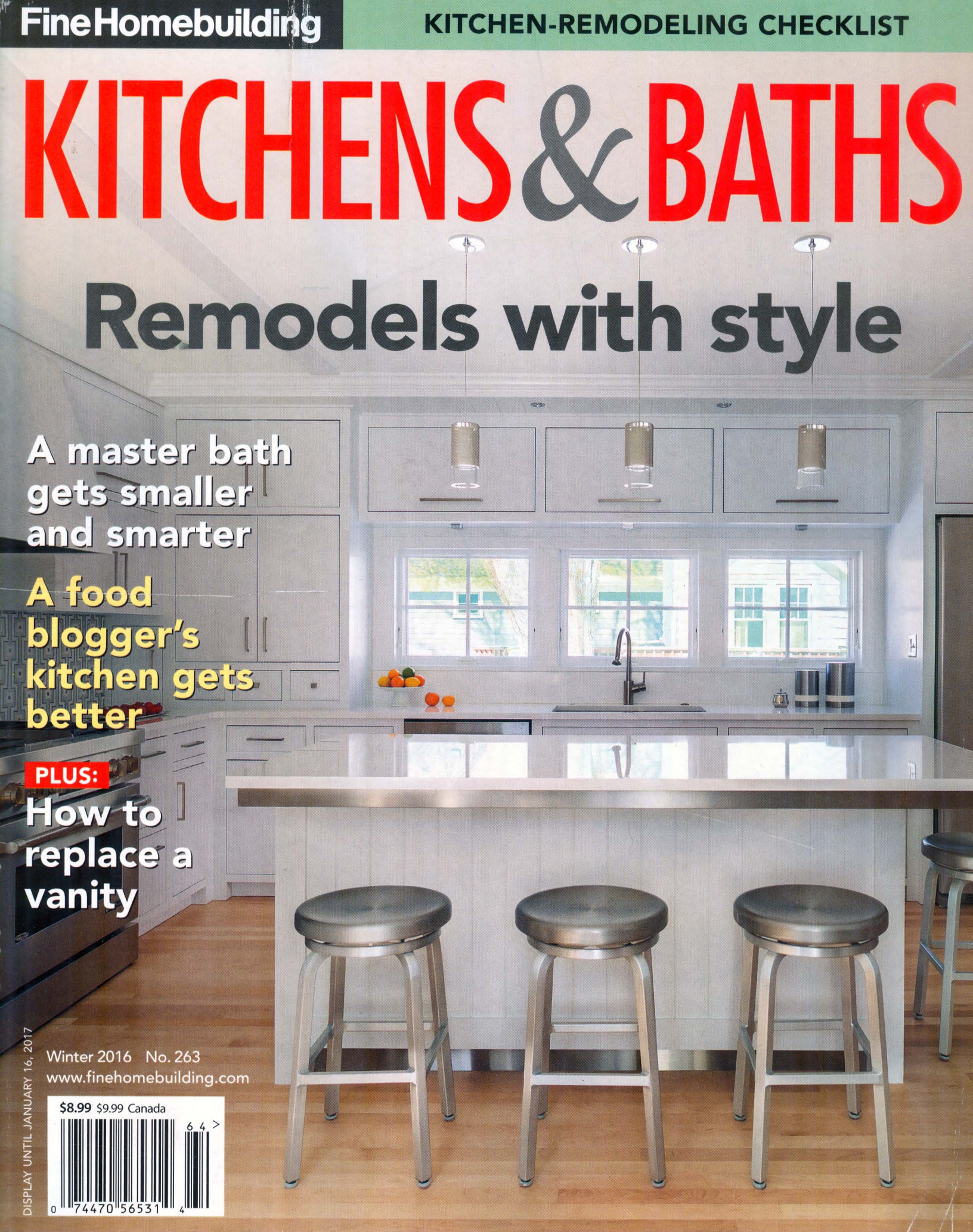

Just because a sink is made for dirty work doesn't mean it shouldn't be attractive

Washing machines and dryers are no longer the plain white boxes they were a generation ago, so you shouldn't settle for an uninspiring plastic slop sink either. The soft, curving edges of the solid ceramic basin and matching hardwood grate may make the Galassia Meg11 the most comfortable sink you'll ever hand wash your laundry in, while its striking lines and proportions would look right at home in the most elegant master bathroom.

DOUBLE-DUTY RADIATOR

With its slim profile and classic good looks, this towel warmer could be the centerpiece of your vintage bath

If you like the idea of grabbing a toasty warm towel after a shower, and if you have a traditional-style bathroom, here's a beautiful alternative to the austere towel warmers found in many modern homes. The Brampton heated towel radiator by Hudson Reed looks like a cross between an antique chrome sink base and a multitube radiator. Hot water is piped through the chrome-plated tubes en route to the central radiator, warming and drying your bath towel along the way.

- Size options: four-column (36⅔ in. high by 17¾ in. wide) and eight-column (36⅔ in. high by 24⅖ in. wide)
- Heat output: 1879 Btu to 3525 Btu
- Requires valves at connection to hot-water supply and return lines
- \$710 to \$815, depending on size and supply-valve options
