It has PVC-free cushion backing for improved indoor air quality, enhanced comfort underfoot and to extend the life of the floor covering compared to other hard-backed carpets, according to the company.

# Natural Wonders

Inspired by nature, infused with design

Du Verre Hardware introduces the Wave collection. Graphically strong, Wave is inspired by sea vistas and the horizon lines of exotic oceans, according to the company. Three finishes enhance the eco-friendly recycled aluminum hardware. Two knobs and four pulls are available in satin nickel, antique brass and oil-rubbed bronze.



MDC has partnered with interior designer Jamie Beckwith to produce Sextant, a wallcovering with a Moorish arabesque shape. Environmentally friendly, it is sourced from a fast-growing Japanese tree called *Psilowmia*. According to the company, Beckwith saw the shape in a 17th-century French church and used it as her muse.

Laminate manufacturer Arborite has released Teak, Aframosia, Rosewood and Macassar patterns as part of its Woodgrain Collection.

Each variation provides a resemblance to real wood texture, while maintaining the affordability and utility of laminate, according to the company.



Ecowood by Pavilion promotes a clean environment with slats made from high-density polyethylene. It is UV-inhibited and impervious to all weather conditions, according to the company.



Designed by RUX, Stickbulbs are sleek wooden beams that contain LED lights and provide the basic building unit for any Stickbulb fixture. The X Diamond 3/60 celebrates the hexagonal and octahedral forms of nature while expanding the potential of the Stickbulb system. The 9-ft.-tall fixture is composed of 60, 3-ft. long Stickbulbs that are connected by polished brass joints. Echoing Stickbulb's commitment to sustainability, the chandelier is crafted from reclaimed Southern Yellow Pine.
