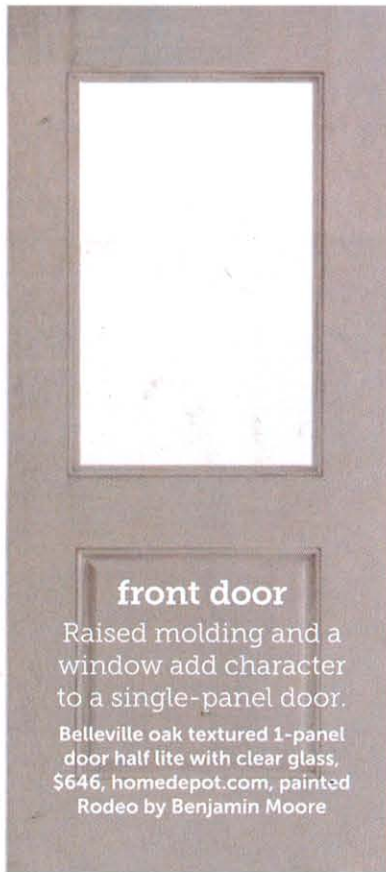

front door

Raised molding and a window add character to a single-panel door.

potted plants

These simple house numbers have a clean, classic style that looks great against a white home.

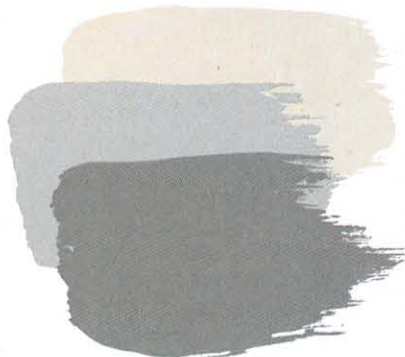
