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Textiles

The products are being made in the company's High Point, NC, facility-which recently installed a solar farm, further adding to the environmental feature of these products.

Bath Design



The tub uses 46.5 gallons of water at its maximum. The tub measures 68 in. long, 293/8 in. wide and 221/8 in. deep.



Vanity

The waterproof, wall-mounted vanities are available in six series: Glass, Wood, Leather, Colours, Picturesque and Radius. Each vanity series features a streamlined design with either straight or rounded edges, and a surface with bold color, art or material treatments. All surfaces are scratch-resistant. waterproof and humidity-resistant. The interior of the vanity features leatherette-lined drawers; it is available in one- or two-drawer models in 24-, 28-, 36-, and 42-in. sizes.







Carpet

Desso Hospitality—a division of Dutch carpet manufacturer Desso—offers Infinity, its new Axminster carpet collection. The collection, created by UK-based Desso designer Jonathan Curell, takes inspiration from the concept of infinity—most particularly, the Atomium in Brussels, which consists of nine spheres connected via 20 tubes. The collection features deep colors, multiple layers and the shapes of circles in fresh designs.

Floor Lamp

Hellman-Chang presents the Anora lamp as its first exploration into lighting. With its roots in the company's celebrated Z line, the Anora lamp is an exercise in balance and poise. Hand Dryer



Lighting

The Glass Bar, a new lighting design from ThinkGlass, features LED lights, which allow the bar to follow the theme color of the room. When the central crystal teardrop chandelier changes color, the bar follows suit.





Beaufurn has introduced the Terza Collection, which offers lounge chairs and sofas that combine comfort and durability. The brushed-steel frame and legs are strong and defined, and they can be upholstered in a wide array of fabrics, including polyester, polyurethane, vinyl, 100% post-consumer recycled polyester and wool/polyamide fabrics.







Tracy Glover has unveiled a sculptural glass statement chandelier and two new sconce designs. The Silver Lining Chandelier (above) showcases hand-blown glass elements suspended on nine individual stainlesssteel cable strands. Nine illuminated glass diffusers are interspersed with non-illuminated orbs. The pieces are customizable as to quantity, size shape, pattern and color: three shapes, five patterns, 16 solid colors, three colorways. In addition, the Wickburn Sconce (left, top) features a hand-blown glass cylinder on a rectangular metal backplate, and the Blackburn Sconce (left) features a hand-blown glass diffuser suspended from a cantilevered post, attached to a metal backplate.
