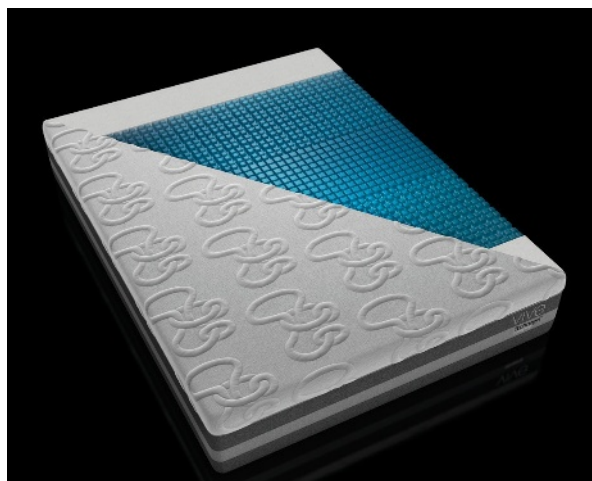
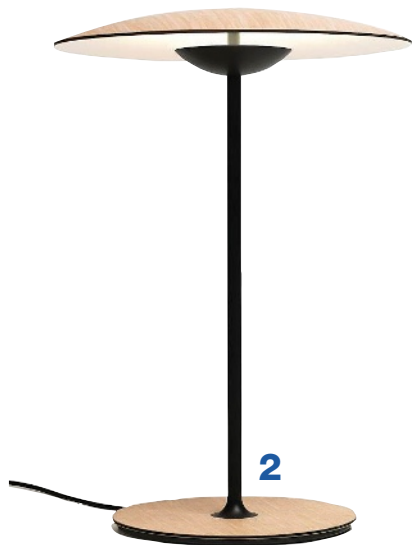

The Oval Chest from **Blue Leaf Hospitality's** Verandah Collection features a deep mahogany-stained, round oak frame, three metallic drawers and a ¼-in. tempered-glass top. The curved drawer fronts are finished with polished-nickel drawer pulls. The full Verandah Collection includes chairs, tables and a headboard.

Designed by Joan Gaspar, the Ginger collection by Barcelona-based lighting company **Marset** is inspired by the drums used by Ginger Baker of the 1960s English rock band Cream. Made from layers of wood and paper that are shaped under high pressure—technology that is new to the industry, according to the company—Ginger features a 4-mm.-thick aerial shade and white interior. It comes in two sizes as a hanging pendant, as well as floor and table models.

Designer Todd Bracher has collaborated with **3M Architectural Markets** on Lightfalls, an architectural lighting fixture that uses the laws of physics to distribute light from a single LED source over a large space by pouring light from one highly reflective surface to another, according to the company. Lightfalls is available in a number of configurations, from a single sconce to forms with three, five or seven reflectors.

Victoria + Albert has added the Staffordshire 15 to its line of traditional-style bath faucets made in England. Its wall-mount option enables the bath tub to be placed closer to the wall for efficiency within smaller bathrooms, according to the company. Equipped with a metal, hand-held shower attachment, which can face left or right, the faucet is available in polished chrome, brushed nickel and polished nickel finishes.

Technogel has launched the Vive collection of gel mattresses and pillows. Made with thick layers of gel placed atop high-quality foam and latex, the items are designed to help with spinal alignment, pressure relief and thermal regulation, according to the company. The pillows are available in classic (shown), deluxe and anatomic versions, while the mattresses come in the following sizes: twin XL, queen (shown), king and California king.
