

- Faucets at home are becoming increasingly user-friendly and efficient. Sensor-operated faucets have been around awhile in the hospitality industry, and nowadays they're making their way into homes as well.
- Toilets, such as the Numi (Kohler's most advanced), combine design, technology and engineering to offer the latest in personal comfort and cleansing. From striking contemporary form and features to water efficiency, toilets bring a new standard of excellence to the bathroom. The Numi features such lavishness as a motion-activated cover and seat, advanced bidet functionality, integrated air dryer, deodorizer, heated seat, foot warmer, chromotherapy and even music.

To be completely on-trend with bath spa technology, two must-haves are hydrotherapy and chromatherapy.

Hydrotherapy tubs include three key components: heat, buoyancy, and massage. Heat speeds up the removal of lactic acid from sore muscles. Muscles heated in warm bath water are less fatigued and recover faster. Buoyancy is an upward force exerted by a liquid, gas or other fluid that opposes the weight of an immersed object. Buoyancy in your tub relieves pressure on the body, tissues and muscles. Massage is the manipulation of superficial and
