Indertaking a total interior renovation is always a challenge, particularly when the space in question is a luxury apartment in one of South Florida's most prestigious addresses, and when the design directive and timetable of a discerning client — an accomplished business professional and art collector — are in the balance. Such is the case of this floor-to-ceiling makeover of an upper-floor space in Miami's five-star Four Seasons Residences Tower, whose units boast panoramic city and seascapes.

Enter architect Kurt Dannwolf, whose back-ground with the building's design and construction proved invaluable to the project — a labor of love that entailed ripping out walls and reconfiguring the space throughout more than two-thirds of the 3,790-square-foot apartment. "Condos have an inherent set of rules and requirements that can be challenging," the architect says.


