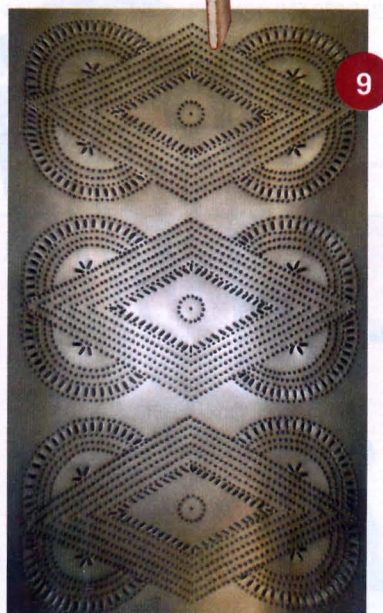
PETITE ISLAND (8)
