Waterfall Bath

Simple but stylish, the Double Take vanity features four large drawers, invisible soft-close hardware, and leather or brushed chrome handles. It comes with a rectangle porcelain sink and a variety of countertop options, including CaesarStone quartz or natural stone. It costs \$3,900 and comes in 13 colors. waterfallbath.com



Nuheat

A heated floor is definitely a luxury, but it doesn't have to cost a mint. These radiant-heat mats are installed under ceramic or stone floors and can be controlled with a wall-mounted thermostat. Available in standard and custom sizes, the system costs about \$10 to \$14. nuheat.com



ICERA Group

The Cadence gravity-fed toilet comes in two versions — a model that uses 1.28 gallons of water and another that sips only 1 gallon per flush. Each WaterSense-certified unit is designed with a fully glazed 2 1/8-in. trap, an anti-microbial bowl and a comfortable chair-height seat. Offered in white, bisque and black, it's priced at \$465. icer-USA.com

LIXIL USA Corp.

Regio is a dual-flush toilet (1.6 gallons of water per flush or 1.1 gallon) that offers automated function, hygienic cleansing and anti-bacterial technology. Illuminated by LED lights, the bowl plays music as the lid automatically opens to uncover a heated seat, and a retractable wand offers personal cleansing. It's priced at \$6,903. inax-usa.com

Diamond Spas specializes in custom copper and stainless steel baths with a seemingly unlimited variety of options. The ellipse soaking tub, for example, can be fabricated with a flat or bowed top ledge, in any size, shape or height. It costs about \$12,500 as shown. diamondspas.com
