Fondazione Bisazza

Since its opening in 2012, the Fondazione Bisazza (above) has hosted exhibits honoring the work of such architectural luminaries as Richard Meier and John Pawson. Until November 23, the foundation is presenting an exhibition in nearby Venice, during the city's Architecture Biennale. The *Glass Tea House Mondrian* exhibit, by the artist Hiroshi Sugimoto, consists of a 131-by-41-foot path along a reflecting pool covered with Bisazza mosaic tiles that leads to a 64-square-foot glass cube, just large enough for two observers, where a traditional Japanese tea ceremony is performed regularly. +39.0444.707690, www.fondazionebisazza.it



VICTORIA AND ALBERT

To enhance the comfort in its volcanic limestone tubs, Victoria and Albert has introduced the Luxury Backrest (\$375) and Tombolo Bath Rack (\$480 as shown). The backrest is cushioned in foam and has a stainless-steel core for stability.
