# Senate Adds Veteran Employment Tax Credit

The U.S. Senate recently added an amendment to provide tax credits to companies that hire veterans. That amendment was part of unanimously approved legislation to repeal a federal mandate that government agencies withhold part of their payments to contractors. The bill must now go back to the House for another vote. The bill is expected to pass the House. President Barack Obama indicated he will sign the amended bill.

In addition to the withholding repeal, the legislation provides a \$5,600 tax credit for each veteran a company hires who has been unemployed for at least six months. Companies also would be offered a \$9,600 tax credit for hiring out-of-work veterans with service-related disabilities. According to a Businessweek.com report, unemployment among the youngest veterans, ages 18-24, was at 30% in October, up from 18.4% a year ago.
