16. Ashby Pulls
• AMEROCK

Deep drawer full of heavy pots, meet your new partner: a sturdy cup pull with period style. It comes in six finishes and will fit existing screw holes 3 or 4 inches wide. \$15; amerock.com

17. 30-Inch Electric Single Wall Oven with IQ-Touch Controls
• ELECTROLUX

No preheating, steam cleans—plus “air sous vide”: Two fans and calibrated temps allow vacuum-packed dishes to cook very slowly. Or just roast a turkey; when it’s done the oven automatically kicks to warm. \$2,299; electroluxappliances.com

18. 36-Inch Induction Cooktop
• BLUESTAR

Best of both worlds: 12 settings and a burner so potent it hard-boils a gallon of water in 3.5 minutes, coupled with comfy knobs. No more punching a sticky touch pad. From \$2,499; bluestarcooking.com

19. Transform Countertop Overlays
• CAESARSTONE

Keep the countertops you have, and let a pro remake them with a thin quartz overlay. No demolition, only the challenge of choosing among 12 stone-look finishes. From \$50 per square foot installed; caesarstoneus.com

MBXFSX5832

• MTI BATHS

A compact 58 inches long and 32 inches wide, this acrylic number has nice edge detailing. Owners of small spaces can also opt for a quick-connect drain (add \$200). From \$2,156; mtibaths.com

23. Real Rain • KOHLER

Rain showerheads don't always deliver, but this ceiling-mount, a generous 19 by 19 inches, lets you control the size of the downpour, so your face doesn't have to get soaked. From \$2,150; kohler.com

24. Gutviken Sink • IKEA

This countertop cutie—the bowl's about 11 inches wide—is ideal for a mini bath. It's china, like a coffee mug, and did we mention the price (water trap included)? \$60; ikea.com

25. Malibu II • ICERA

Measuring only 28 inches front to back and fitted for a 10-inch rough-in, this ADA-compliant, low-flush toilet nonetheless has a slightly elongated bowl and a skirted base. From \$495; icerausa.com

26. Glacio Knobs
• AMEROCK

Seeing is wanting to touch these dainty knobs. In three shapes and five finishes, they're clear with mirror-topped mountings—and could make a salvaged-wood vanity look luxurious. \$9.99 each; amerock.com

27. Handmade Cement Tile • SABINE HILL

We can't get enough of the vintage cement-tile look—and now we have these 8-inch-square tiles (.71 inch thick) to pore over. From top to bottom: Flagstaff, Stella, Maize, and Kiva. From \$24 per square foot; sabinehill.com

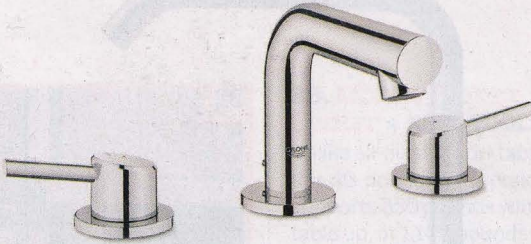
20. Concetto Lavatory Wideset • GROHE

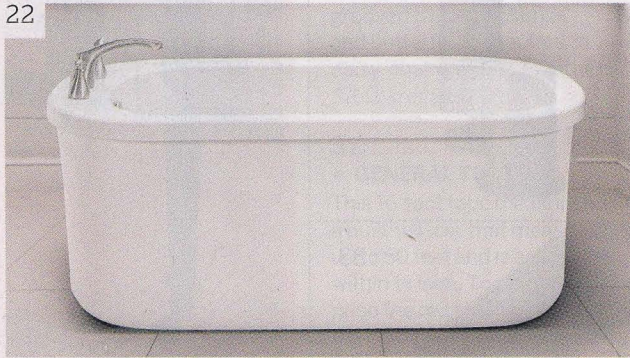
21. 48-Inch Nellie Farmhouse Sink Vanity

Who let the farmhouse sink out of the kitchen? The same genius who incorporated it into a granite-topped 48-inch vanity with bun feet, beadboard panels,

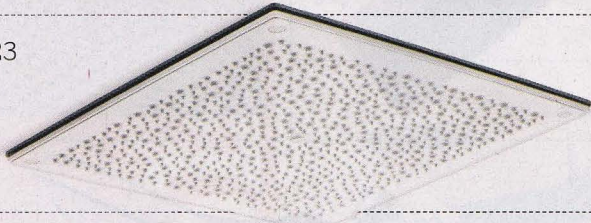
