





STONE FOREST, SYNC SERIES

With stainless steel brackets and a grill-style drain, these sinks thwart the rustic aesthetic inherent to so many stone basins. The brackets act as attachment points for countertops, or they can stitch together two sinks with a counter between them. Coordinating wall shelves are optional. Stone choices include Carrara marble, honed basalt and onyx. \$3,350 as pictured (four pieces). 888-682-2987; stoneforest.com.

★ Honorable Mention TOTALLY BAMBOO, VESSEL SINK

Master craftsmen hand turn each of these bamboo basins on a massive lathe, then carefully rub the bowl to a satin finish. That's all well and good, but what makes these sinks so noteworthy are all the things that are good about bamboo: it's durable, warm and much easier on the environment than hardwood. A polyurethane finish makes the sink waterproof. \$500. 760-471-6600; totallybamboo.com.

LASERTRON, CABINET WITH LIGHTED DOORS

Innovation meets solid construction in this ingenious medicine cabinet. The doors light up, both illuminating the inside of the cabinet and providing a night light for the bathroom. The door frames are stainless steel with welded corners and rolled edges, but with no exposed screws or welds, for a clean appearance. The glass front includes a fingerprint-resistant coating to make upkeep easier. \$495. 945-846-8600; lasertron.com.



Honorable Mention DURAVIT, HAPPY D SERIES VANITY

Tidy and practical, this vanity provides both useful storage and an attractive profile. As its name indicates, the unit is indeed D-shaped, sporting a curved front that perfectly matches the sink. Inside the cabinet door, which conveniently hides the plumbing, is a glass shelf with double railing to keep supplies in place.
