The newest addition to the M'Afrique collection, Shadowy's form references the curve of a scorpion's tail. Created by London-based industrial product designer Tord Boontje, the piece combines a steel frame and handwoven polyethylene fishing ropes. Suitable for indoor and outdoor use.

The Incline rectangular basin's sloped bottom includes an integrated slotted drain along the back of its 19-by-15-in. bowl. Made from solid SculptureStone, this unit is available as a counter or vanity sink in either white or biscuit matte.

43 MAJESTIC MIRROR & FRAME

Argyle is illuminated by two vertical backlit LED lights. The mirror panel comes in a standard 22.5-by-48.5-in. size, but custom mirror sizes and T5 LED light tube lengths are also available.

Charme, a modern wing chair designed by the company's studio in Barcelona, is made with cold-cure foam molded over a metallic frame. Available with a choice of solid ash legs or a metallic swivel base.
