IT ALL STARTED WITH THE WALLPAPER. When Caroline Davis laid eyes upon Cole and Son's swirling Mimosa pattern, she immediately envisioned it in the master bath in her Washington, D.C., home. "I thought it would imbue the room with depth and warmth," she says. "There's a movement to this design that calms and softens things." But the space needed more than just new wallpaper. With its heavy terra-cotta tile, disorienting ceiling (low in some spots, steeply pitched in others), and 20-year-old fixtures, the bath begged for a complete overhaul. So, Mimosa sample in hand, Caroline and her husband, Brandon Partridge, went to David Waguespack at D.C.'s Case Architects & Remodelers.

Waguespack took the 12×13-foot room down to the studs, evening out the ceiling and introducing a symmetrical floor plan with a bank of custom cabinetry on one side and windows on the other. A pair of glass enclosures—one frosted to conceal the toilet, the other a crystal-clear walk-in shower—flank a shapely soaking tub. "We went clean and modern on that side of the room," Waguespack says. "The wallpaper needed some juxtaposition to keep things fresh." Next came a smart assortment of finishes, also chosen with the wallpaper in

mind. "Slate-stained cabinets, gray-veined countertops, aged-brass sconces—they all echo the muted grays, browns, and whites found in the Mimosa motif," Waguespack says. Pops of pink, by way of fresh roses and fragrant bath salts, complement the bath's feminine aesthetic, while the double windows capitalize on natural light.

Caroline and Brandon now start each day in a striking bath that's overflowing with storage and sunlight. But for Caroline, it all comes back to that wallpaper: "It makes me incredibly happy," she says. "Besides marrying my husband, it might be the best decision I've ever made."

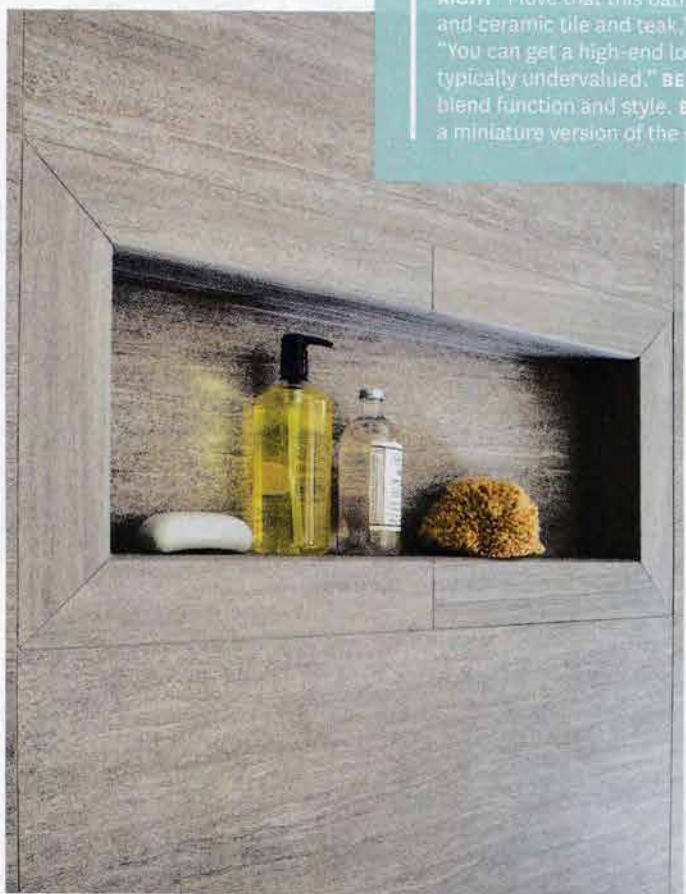

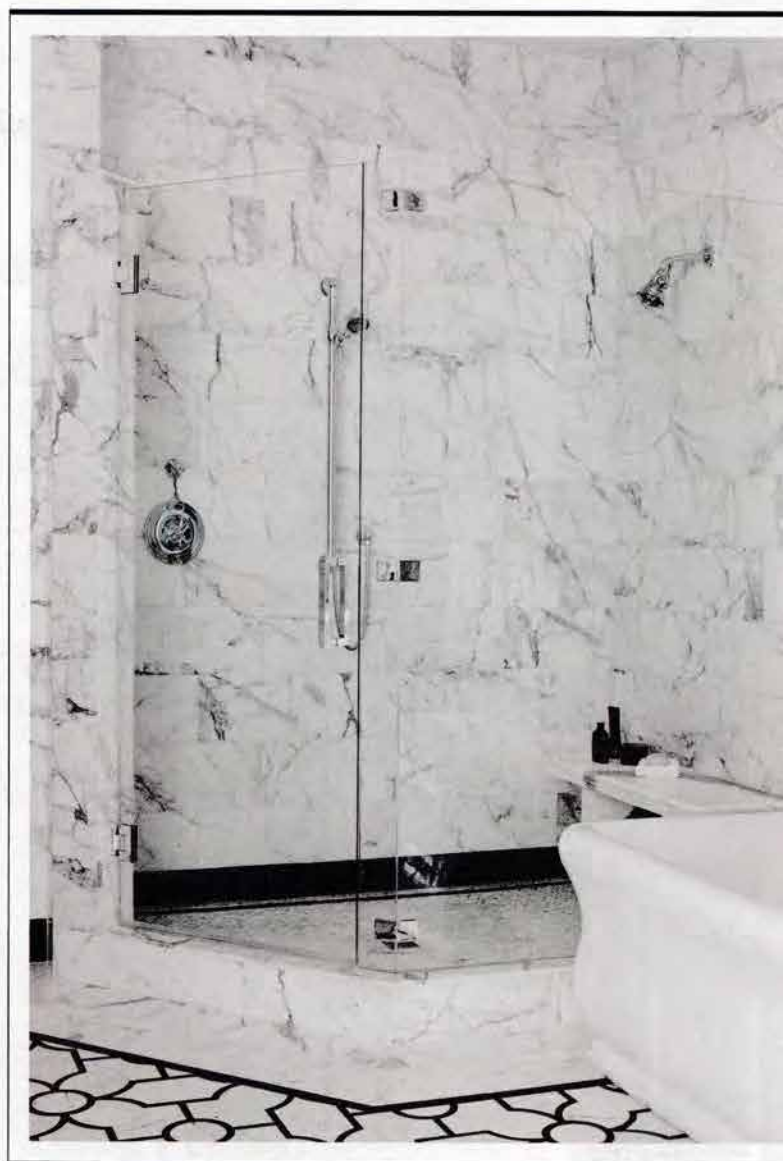

LIKE ANY THOUGHTFULLY CREATED SPACE, this chic and elegant master bath is the product of a designer listening carefully before ever picking up a pencil. Interior designer Valarie Zeh had worked with the owners before and knew that they were partial to black and white—but this time their request was to “soften the space” and give it a more feminine feel. They were also keen on avoiding the nautical kitsch often found in waterfront homes.

“We wanted the master bath to feel very luxurious but still coastal and underplayed—charming with a modern edge,” Zeh says of the home on St. Simons Island, Georgia. “The homeowners love the elegant sophistication that comes with black and white but felt it was very masculine. By working in shades of gray and being mindful of sharp details, the space became warmer with more feminine qualities.”

White marble with rich gray veining serves as a serene backdrop, covering the walls from floor to ceiling and repeating in the frameless shower enclosure. On the floor, a large black-and-white marble inlay mimics an elegant area rug. Its striking graphic pattern offers the perfect counterpoint to the room’s subdued shades of gray.

The star of the bath, a sculptural freestanding tub with shapely curves, tucks below a window dressed with a simple white Roman shade trimmed in black. A telephone-style tub filler adds a just-right touch of vintage character and enhances the bath’s feminine feel.



ABOVE “The frameless shower shows off the seamless cohesiveness of the marble walls,” Zeh says. Black marble along the bottom of the wall and around the perimeter of the shower floor adds subtle definition and depth. The shower’s angled door maximizes the bathroom’s footprint.

Steps away, dual custom vanities resemble elegant pieces of furniture, with plenty of storage below to keep the tops clutter-free. Frameless oversize mirrors above the vanities appear as though they’re floating off the wall—their deliberate lack of embellishment keeps the focus squarely on the breathtaking marble around them.

“The design is timeless and elegant, livable yet polished,” Zeh says. “Putting the tile everywhere encased the bath in luxury and elegance. When you walk inside, the feeling is, ‘Ahh.’ It’s sublime.”
