MTI Baths' latest addition to the Boutique Collection is Eryx, which will be on display. Eryx is a wall-mounted vanity sink inspired by the art of the human form. Renowned kitchen and bath designer Matthew Quinn collaborated with MTI engineering and manufacturing to create the Eryx vanity sink. Ideal for either deck-mounted or wall-mounted faucets, Eryx incorporates a 17" x 17" bowl that slopes downward 15 degrees from the front and meets a slotted drain that spans the full width of the bowl. The sink bowl is available in white or biscuit, matte or gloss finish, while the legs are available in a variety of colors. The Eryx can also be customized with a longer bowl to serve a wash station in a large master bath or in a commercial bathroom.

The Elena tub, model 220, is being shown with a flat rim and nestled in a cradle whose lines mimic the ends of the tub. The cradle is handcrafted in steel and powder-coated in a matte black finish. As with all MTI products, the Elena tub is crafted in the United States and finished by hand to exacting quality standards.

MTI Baths' award-winning Integrated Deck Designs will also be on display. These customized partial surrounds are constructed according to the desires, needs and spaces of the customer. They snugly cradle the freestanding tub and actually accentuate its exterior lines, all while providing a mounting space for faucets and a resting place for book, electronic device or beverage. Hotel Operations has a very difficult time cleaning behind freestanding tubs. Integrated Deck Designs eliminates the problem and allows the use of deck-mounted tub fillers that are more affordable than floor-mounted fillers. Available in a wide variety of designs and finishes, it also provides a concealed place for air bath blower motors and also provides easy access.





All three products are constructed using MTI's proprietary SculptureStone material -- Engineered Solid Stone that is approximately 70% organic materials and high-performance resins. The finished product is non-porous, stain-, mold-, and mildew-resistant, making cleaning and maintenance easy.
