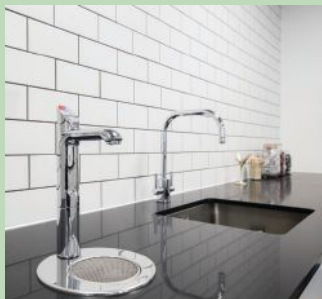
# KITCHEN

## Measured Fill

The Beale MeasureFill Touch Kitchen Faucet by American Standard delivers a precise set volume of water for baking and cooking. The dial selects up to 5 cups, or 40 ounces; a single touch starts water flowing. The faucet includes an ADA-approved lever handle for manual faucet operation and a retractable spray head.
