Paging all audiophiles! Styled after '80s and '90s stereo systems, **Hi-Fi** reimagines the volume and tone dials of such newly vintage audio equipment as shower mixers. Cylindrical knobs reminiscent of high-fidelity analogic equalizers regulate the "symphony" of water. Adjusting the flow-rate knob—equipped with a precision-tick rotation system inspired by high-end watches—gives the user the impression of "tuning" the volume of water, while a secondary knob controls temperature. Push rectangular buttons evocative of stereo amplifier keys to select rain, mist, waterfall, hand-shower, or body-jet functions. Components are predominately brass with finishes including nickel, copper, matte white or black, brushed brass, and aged bronze. Play on. gessi.com ➔
