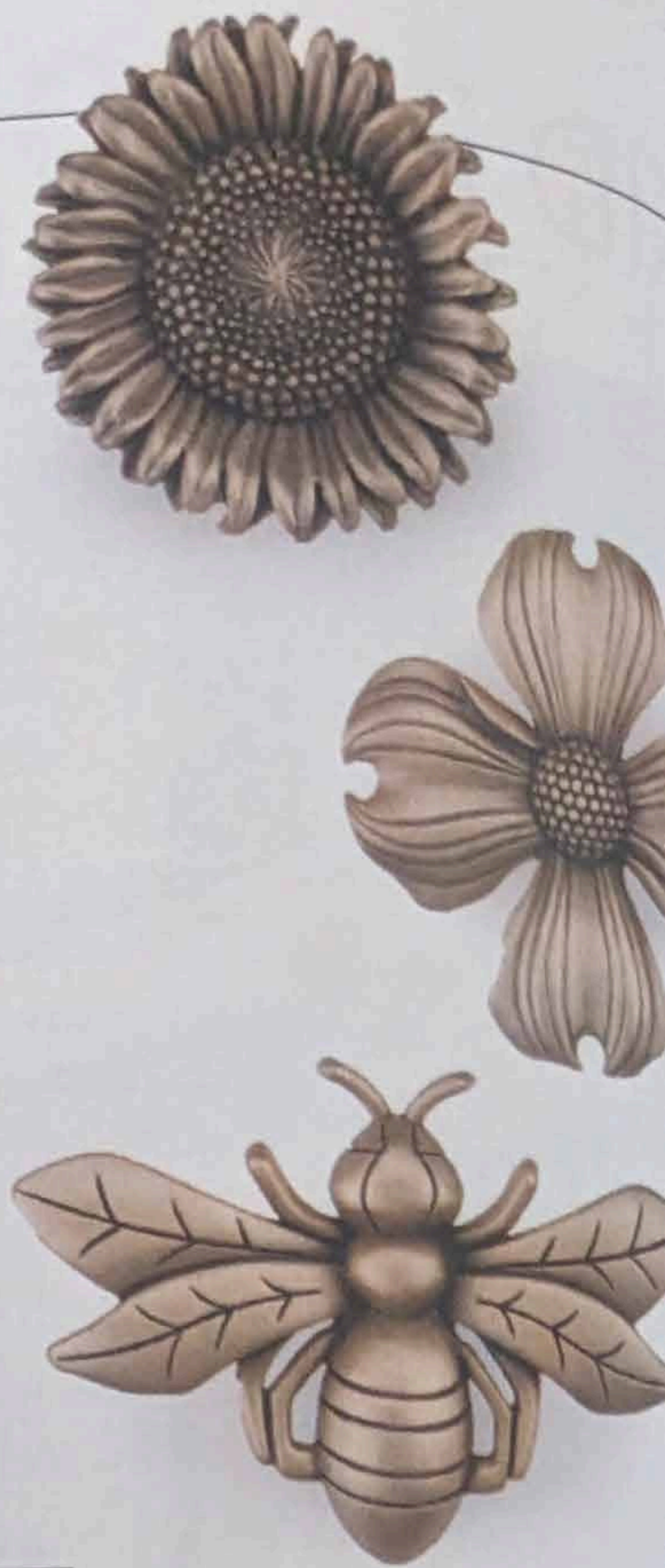
1. FIFTIES COLOR

2. TAKEN FROM NATURE

The sunflower, dogwood, and bee cabinet knobs from the Artisan collection are cast in lead-free pewter with realistic, three-dimensional detailing. They're shown in the Museum Gold finish. Measurements vary; \$24 each. Acorn Manufacturing, (508) 339-4500, acornmfg.com

3. JUST INTRODUCED

The Soleil cabinet knob is part of a new line of cabinet hardware made in solid forged brass and lead-free crystal. All pieces are offered in nine finishes, including Vintage Brass (shown). The knobs measure 1⅜" wide; \$22.48 each. Grandeur, (800) 522-7336, grandeurhardware.com

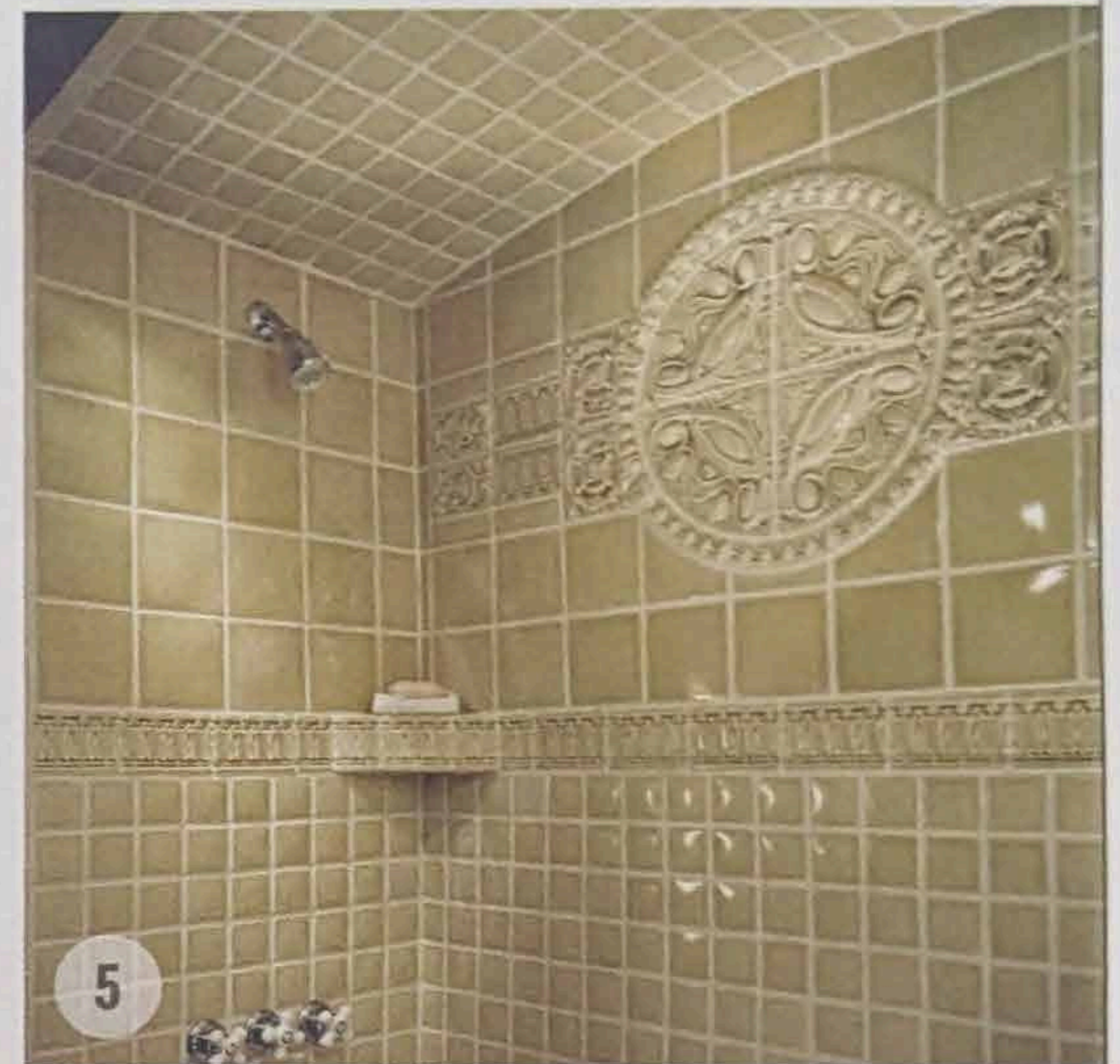


4. RIBBED HANDLES

Ribbed-glass cup handles were popular around the turn of the 20th century. Each cup pull measures 1¼" high x 3½" wide, with a 1¼" projection. Also available in amber glass in a 3¾" width. They're \$13.95 each. Dwyer Home Collection, (727) 631-1770, dwyerhomecollection.com

FINE ACCENTS FOR A BOLD BATH

NEW PRODUCTS TRADITIONAL AND EXTRAVAGANT.

1. DOUBLE GLEAM The Double Robe Hook in polished nickel is from the Charlie's Collection of Alno Hardware. Solid brass, 4½" wide with a 2½" projection, it comes in nine finishes. Cost is about \$76-96 at My Knobs, myknobs.com

2. PRISMS OF LIGHT Crystal conveys elegance. These cabinet pieces with solid-brass fittings (in many finishes) come from Nostalgic Warehouse. From \$18 to \$24 per piece; doorknob sets about \$93. nostalgicwarehouse.com

3. OLD WORLD MOOD In finishes including oil-rubbed bronze, old iron, and verde, the hand-forged iron #5123-2 Transitional Spanish Double Wall Sconce is 25" H x 19½" W with a 10½" extension. It's \$479. lightsoftuscany.com

4. A CLASSIC FAUCET The wall-mounted, Vintage 3-Hole faucet with cross handles alludes to early-20th-century designs. Solid brass in nine finishes including polished nickel, the low-arc spout has a

total reach of 10½". Starting at \$389.95. kingstonbrass.com

5. TILE FINESSE Comprising curved borders, "wings," and a quartet of interior tiles, the Sullivan-esque Armitage Collection tiles may be used in various combinations. Glazes here are Light Sand and Sand. motawi.com

6. JUNGLE BIN Marye-Kelley creates handsome wastepaper bins, handmade in the USA, in styles traditional to wild and can match a bin to your wallpaper. Bins are wood or tin, 11 to 17 inches tall. 'African Animal Obsession on Black' is priced from \$120. marye-kelley.com

7. LAVATORY LUXURY Slender and sculptural, the Stone Forest (stoneforest.com) 'Renaissance' console sink is a splurge that will last several lifetimes. The leggy base (in three finishes) is \$3,984; a honed Carrara-marble top is \$3,332. Through dealers including qualitybath.com
