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A Treetop *Retreat*

With the latest in technology and uninterrupted lines of sight to the outdoors, this primary bathroom is a haven of calm.

Full height medicine cabinets behind the wall mirrors add more storage in the vanity area.

It's hard to imagine that this stunning master bath once had a dated aesthetic, awkward layout and nonfunctioning bathtub. Thanks to the team at Anthony Wilder Design/Build, this family of avid bathers now soaks in the beauty of their new renovation.

The color palette in this space is intentionally minimal to let the gorgeous Maryland view speak for itself. A selection of natural wood tones, whites and blues create a relaxing, spa-like feel. Brushed brass elevates the tone yet does not compete with the beauty outside the floor-to-ceiling windows. The one-of-a-kind focal point is unmistakably the freestanding sculpture stone bathtub. Meanwhile, the natural aesthetic is carried into the shower with the veining in the full height slab walls, taking advantage of the tall ceilings and unique shape of the space.



The natural walnut floating vanity and the extended custom mirrors are just high enough to catch the reflection of the skylights into the room. Heated floors, a digital shower system and a state-of-the-art Washlet toilet seat all function with the touch of a button. Creating ample storage for medicines and linens while achieving a streamlined look was a challenge. To solve this issue, the team added an entry hall with a large linen closet, featuring custom, adjustable, roll-out trays and two full height recessed medicine cabinets in the main space, providing more than enough storage.
