The hundreds of products posted to QualifiedRemodeler.com keep remodelers and home improvement pros versed on the new releases and product innovations that could come in handy on a jobsite or be the perfect fit for a design project, giving the property owner exactly what they've been looking for.

The Remodelers Choice 100 is a compendium of the most requested products published on QualifedRemodeler.com over the past 12 months. The listed products—arranged in alphabetical order by the manufacturer's name—generated the most clicks, pageviews, and interactions of all recently published product pages. That's to say, they were quite popular, and for good reason. The 100 most-requested products run the gamut from kitchen and bath to exterior and outdoor living, along with niche product categories that serve essential functions on many remodeling projects. Some are no-brainers, like many tried-and-true siding and roofing options, but others are more distinctive, such as bright and bold colors options and game-altering innovations.

A few words on methodology: *Qualified Remodeler*'s editors compiled a list of the 250 most-viewed product pages from April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025, then filtered out those older than a few years to ensure all products were still fresh. The editors then performed a quality check on all listings, weeding out any duplicates or minor product updates that didn't quite fit the list's criteria.
